Conditions of entry

- 1. All competitors and spectators ride and enter the grounds at their own risk.
- 2. Helmets must meet current standards and have a yellow tag attached. If you have a new helmet and require a yellow tag, we can do this for a gold coin donation. Just ask at the office.
- 3. Only Pony Club approved bits to be used. No double bridles.
- 4. Competition attire or Pony Club uniform for all rings. Plaiting optional.
- 5. Parking is in the area around the sand arena.
- 6. All flat classes will take place in the cross-country paddock through the gate behind the container.
- 7. Cross country jumps are not to be jumped.
- 8. The organising committee reserve the right to restrict entries if necessary and/or alter the programme and split or combine classes.
- 9. Recreational classes 2, 3 and 4 may be split differently on the day dependant on the number of entries
- 10. Judge's reserve the right to redirect riders to another ring.
- 11. Judge's decision is final.
- 12. Rider age is the riders age on the day.
- 13. Champion will be judged from 1st place getters from designated classes. 2nd place getters to be on standby.
- 14. Any unruly or lame horses will be asked to leave the ring.
- 15. No stallions permitted.
- 16. All dogs must be kept on a lead at all times. No exceptions.
- 17. Cancellations will be announced on the Inglewood Pony Club NZ Facebook page by 7.30am
