Conditions of entry

1. All competitors and spectators ride and enter the grounds at their own risk.
2. Helmets must meet current standards and have a red tag attached. If you have a new helmet and require a red tag, we can do this for a gold coin donation. Just ask at the office.
3. Only Pony Club approved bits to be used. No double bridles.
4. Rings 1- 4 may wear competition attire or Pony Club uniform.
5. Rings 5-8 require competition attire.
6. Parking is in the area around the sand arena. More parking will be available at the saleyards if required.
7. All classes will take place in the cross-country paddock through the gate behind the container.
8. Cross country jumps are not to be jumped.
9. The organising committee reserve the right to restrict entries if necessary and/or alter the programme or split or combine classes.
10. Judge's reserve the right to redirect riders to another ring.
11. Judge's decision is final.
12. Horse/pony/rider combinations can only enter one ring.
13. Rider age classes is the child's age on the day.
14. Champion will be judged from 1st place getters from designated classes. 2nd place getters to be on standby.
15. Ribbons 1st-4th
16. Any unruly horses will be asked to leave the ring.
17. Included in the entry fee is an Area Pony Club Levy of \$2.00 per rider and a \$3 ground levy per horse/pony
18. All dogs must be kept on lead at all times.
19. Cancellation will be announced on the Inglewood Pony Club NZ Facebook page by 7.30am
